

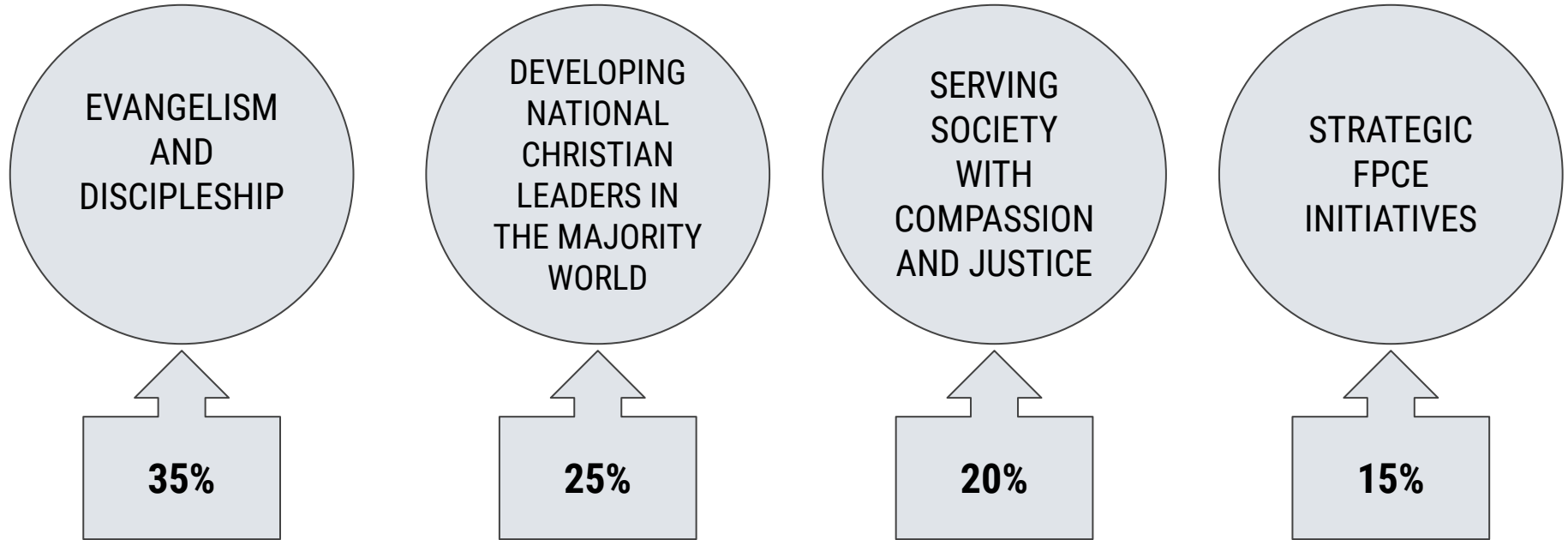

FPCE Outreach Ministries

- Ministries initiated by FPCE
- Run by FPCE Members
- Operated locally, though may have global aspect
- Includes:
 - Short-term missions
 - Mission classes/programs
 - Evanston oriented outreach

Souper Saturday - Serving home-cooked meals to the homeless and working poor

Prison Ministries - Serving prisoners and their families

First Friends - Serving refugees locally

Evanston Ministries - Warming Center, Overnight Shelter, and local needs

Build Congo Schools Serving Group - Focused on education and care for the vulnerable in the D.R. Cong

Mission Classes - Sundry mornings and other programs engaging participants to better understand God's work on the world

Short Term Mission Projects (STEM) - One time grants to help FPCE attendees and friends experience mission locally and internationally

New Life Shelter - Serving Families of the New Life Shelter through meals, tutoring, and more
