ABOUT THE SPEAKERS



Dr. Chris Wright is the International Ministries Director of Langham Partnership, respected theologian and award-winning author of *The Mission of God: Unlocking the Bible's Grand Narrative*. He was chair of the Lausanne Theology Working Group from 2005-11 and the chief architect of The Cape Town Commitment from the Third Lausanne Congress, 2010.



Dr. Ruth Padilla DeBorst has been involved in theological education for integral mission in her native Latin America for many years. A sought-after speaker around the world, Ruth serves in leadership with several organizations—including World Vision and the Latin American Theological Fellowship.



Dr. Myrto Theocharous is professor of Hebrew and Old Testament at Greek Bible College in Athens, Greece, where she was the first evangelical woman to study theology. She has a deep concern for women who are subject to human trafficking and prostitution, and she has been an outspoken advocate for their care and rescue.



Dr. David Zac Niringiye is an internationally recognized theologian, pastor, and social activist in Uganda. In 2012 he took an early retirement as bishop of the diocese of Kampala to advocate for the most vulnerable in his nation.
